Galatians 1:11–12 For I would have you know, brethren, that the **gospel** which was preached by me is not according to man. 12 For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a **revelation** of **Jesus Christ.**

Exodus 3:14 God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.' "

John 8:56–59 "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad." 57 So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" 58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." 59 Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

John's gospel records seven statements where Jesus says "I am".

- "I am the bread of life" (John 6:35, 41, 48, 51)
- "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12; 9:5)
- "I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11, 14)
- "I am the resurrection and the life" (John 11:25)
- "I am the way and the truth and the life" (John 14:6)
- "I am the true vine" (John 15:1, 5)

John 18:4–5 So Jesus, knowing all the things that were coming upon Him, went forth and said to them, "Whom do you seek?" 5 They answered Him, "Jesus the Nazarene." He said to them, "I am He." And Judas also, who was betraying Him, was standing with them.

6 So when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground.

"Jesus" [iesous] - "Jehovah is salvation" or "Jehovah is the Savior"

A controversy in the church

The debate is centered on the ______
of saving faith.

"Free Grace"

1. It ignores the standards that God sets forth for the Christian life.

2. Because of their minimal expectation, many are deceived into thinking they have eternal life when they do not.

"Reformed view"

1. Salvation is based on God's sovereign grace though faith but there must evidences of a changed life such as repentance, obedience, and good works as a result of one's conversion.

Titus 2:11–14 - "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to **redeem** us from all lawlessness and to **purify** for himself a people for his own possession who are **zealous for good works**"

Acts 22:10 "And I said, 'What shall I do, Lord?'

Acts 9:15 But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a **chosen instrument of Mine**, to bear My name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel;

Acts 26:16 'But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to **appoint you** a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you;

1 Timothy 1:12–16 I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, **putting me into service**, 13 even though I was formerly a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. Yet I was shown mercy because I acted ignorantly in unbelief;

John 15:16 "You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit ...

2 Corinthians 5:18–20 Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, 19 namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. 20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

Luke 6:46–49 "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? 47 "Everyone who comes to Me and hears My words and acts on them, I will show you whom he is like: 48 he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid a foundation on the rock; and when a flood occurred, the torrent burst against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built.

49 "But the one who has heard and has **not acted** accordingly, is like a man who built a house on the ground without any foundation; and the torrent burst against it and immediately it collapsed, and the ruin of that house was great."

Implication

Salvation creates a new life that	itself
to the will of Christ.	

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a **new creature**; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.
