<u>John 14:16</u> – I will ask the Father, and He will give you another **Helper**, that He may be with you forever;

<u>John 14:26</u> – But the **Helper**, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

<u>John 15:26</u> – "When the **Helper** comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, that is the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me,

<u>John 16:7</u> – But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the **Helper** will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

 This concept broadens from 'Savior of Israel' to 'Savior of the world' in the NT, but there are hints of this throughout the OT.

Gen. 3:15 – "And I will put enmity
Between you and the woman,
And between your seed and her seed;
He shall bruise you on the head,
And you shall bruise him on the heel."

<u>Gen. 22:18</u> – "In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

- The title means more than just a king, but certainly not less.

 - It represents the payment made by Christ's death.

<u>Heb. 10:4, 12, 14</u> – For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins...¹²but He [Christ], having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God...¹⁴For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.
