Passage: Philippians 2:12-18

## Context from 2:1-11 -

•	'Work out your	with fear and trembling'
	(vv12–13)	

<sup>12</sup>So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling; <sup>13</sup>for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.

- o 'So then' -
- 'Work out your salvation' (cf. Phil. 1:28; Rom. 4:5; Rom. 10:10; Eph. 2:8–9; 1 Thess. 5:9) –
- o 'With fear and trembling' -
- O Why/how can we do this? —

•	'Do without grumbling or disputing'	
	(vv14–16)	
	<sup>14</sup> Do all things without grumbling or disputing; <sup>15</sup> so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world, <sup>16</sup> holding fast the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I will have reason to glory because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain.	
<ul> <li>Witnessing by doing what the world <u>cannot</u> do on its own</li> </ul>		
	(cf. John 17:20–23) –	
	<ul> <li>Encouraging those of the faith —</li> </ul>	
•	'Rejoiceand rejoice' (vv17–18)	
	$^{17}$ But even if I am being poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I rejoice and share my joy with you all. $^{18}$ You too, I urge you, rejoice in the same way and share your joy with me.	
	<ul> <li>Why Paul doesn't care about the cost –</li> </ul>	

○ Why Paul wants them to rejoice as he does —
