• Why Shouldn't We Love the \_\_\_\_\_?

- Three ways John uses the word 'world' (κόσμος [kösmös])
  - 1. Creation (3:17; 4:17; John 1:10)
  - 2. Humanity

<u>1 John 2:2</u> – and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole **world**.

<u>John 3:16</u> – "For God so loved the **world**, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."

3. The Evil World System under Satan (3:1; 4:3–5; 5:19;

John 16:11)

<u>John 15:18–19</u> – "If the **world** hates you, you know that it has hated Me before it hated you. <sup>19</sup>If you were of the **world**, the **world** would love its own; but because you are not of the **world**, but I chose you out of the **world**, because of this the **world** hates you."

John isn't saying that we should hate all of \_\_\_\_\_\_,

but rather that we can't love the world as it is.

<u>James 4:4</u> – You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

We have to remember that the unredeemed world *hates* God, so we can't be seduced by ut.

•	Why Shouldn't We Love the	?
	$\circ$ 'In the world'=part of it, as opposed to believers (i.e., John	
	17:15–16)	
	<ul> <li>Since the world is</li> </ul>	God, whatever is a

part of it would be too.

• Three examples of what is 'in the world':

- 1. The lust of the flesh –
- 2. The lust of the eyes –
- 3. The boastful pride of life –
- All sin can be traced back to these three.

<u>Gen. 3:6</u> – When the woman saw that the tree was **good for food**, and that it was a **delight to the eyes**, and that the tree was **desirable to make one wise**, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.

- Significantly, Jesus succeeded where the first Adam failed (Matt. 4:1–11).
- We can't love 'things in the world' because they are the roots of sin!

- How Should We \_\_\_\_\_ about the World?
  - We forget that the world won't win in the end because it's where we live.

  - Doing God's will puts us against the flow of the world, but we will be the ones who are victorious in the end.

## What Do We Do with These Truths?

1. Everyone must decide between the world or \_\_\_\_\_\_.
