<u>1 John 3:22</u> – and whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do the things that are pleasing in His sight.

<u>John 15:7</u> – "**If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you**, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you."

The more we know God as revealed in His Word, the more our prayers will align with His will and be answered positively.

<u>1 John 2:27</u> – As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.
