 - Purifying (ch3)

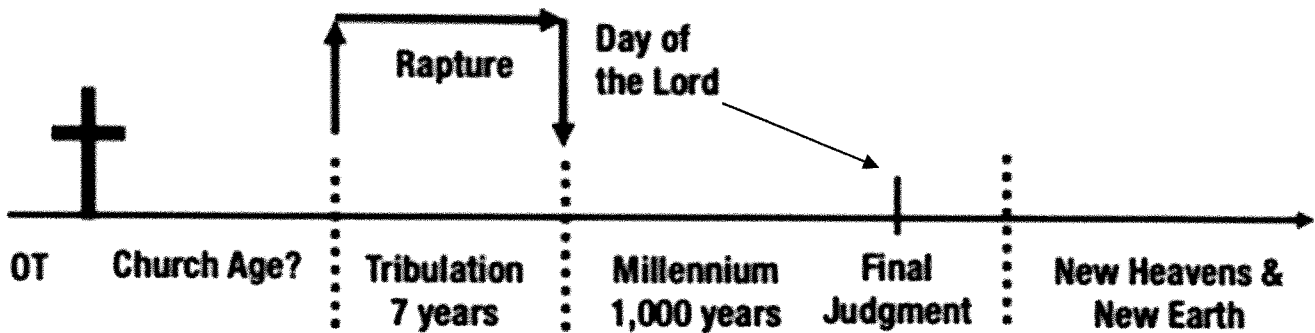
