- The keys of death and hades: Christ controls and decides who dies, who lives, and when.
- Therefore write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which will take place after these things: His sovereign glory and His Church are His priority.

### • Lesson Takeaways

- What is our proper posture as believers before the purifying and judging Authority?
  - Believers will give an account of our lives to God, not to secure salvation but of our deeds. (Romans 14: 10-12)
  - Will we approach Jesus in godly fear, humility, and worship OR are we just giving Him a try out? "Coffee Shop Jesus"

- Do we believe that this purifying and judging Authority loves us?
  - Mentality of Loves vs. Loved
  - Paradox of knowing our inner self and believing His Word that He truly LOVES us.

- The Day of the Lord vs. The Lord's Day

○ Day of the Lord -

- The Lord's Day –
  - Him who is and who was and who is to come
    - A Jewish way of understanding the name \_\_\_\_\_ (I AM).

- **Priesthood of the believer**
  - 1 Peter 2: 4-5 <sup>4</sup> And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by people, but is choice and precious in the sight of God, <sup>5</sup> you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices that are acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

- **John's Vision**

- Seven lampstands: Represent the fullness and completeness of Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ Son of Man: Implies Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ in the look of humanity.
  - Robe reaching to feet with golden sash:
  - His head and His hair were white like white wool, like snow: glory and holiness for eternity.
  - Eyes like a flame of fire: piercing, discerning, understanding.
  - Feet were like burnished bronze, when it has been made to glow in a furnace: "the feet of kings" in His \_\_\_\_\_.
  - Voice like the sound of many waters:
  - Overpowering in drowning out all false messages.
- Seven stars: Seven "ang-el-os" - literally in the Greek as messengers. Can be translated as angels. Christ holds and delivers His messengers – probably the elder tasked with delivering the message to each church.
  - Out of His mouth came a sharp, two-edged sword: the defense and judgement of those who \_\_\_\_\_ His bride (the Church).
  - His face was like the sun shining in its strength: the Church is made to reflect His light to the world.
- **The Second Coming of Christ**
  - Contrast this reality for the repentant and the unrepentant.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ will see Him.
  - Christ will appear "with the clouds" and His \_\_\_\_\_ will be visible.
  - The Second Coming of Christ or The Lord's Return is not the same as the \_\_\_\_\_.
- **In the Spirit on The Lord's Day**
  - "\_\_\_\_\_ and "\_\_\_\_\_ are critical to interpretation in that John is describing the nearly indescribable.
- **John's reaction to the vision.**
  - Fell at His feet like a dead man: the natural result of holy reverence and worship.
