Matthew 7:13–27 “Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. 14 “For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

15 “Beware of the false prophets, who come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly are ravenous wolves.

16 “You will know them by their fruits. Grapes are not gathered from thorn bushes nor figs from thistles, are they? 17 “So every good tree bears good fruit, but the bad tree bears bad fruit. 18 “A good tree cannot produce bad fruit, nor can a bad tree produce good fruit.

19 “Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. 20 “So then, you will know them by their fruits.

21 “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven,

22 “Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?’ 23 “And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.’

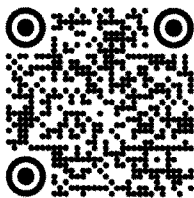

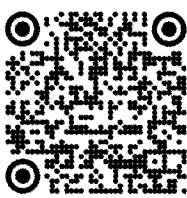

Discussion Guide

1. Jesus says the narrow gate is "difficult to find" and "few find it." In a culture where spirituality is everywhere, why do you think the true and complete Gospel remains so rare and unpopular?
2. Jesus tells us to identify false prophets (and by extension, false converts) by their fruit. Beyond just "doing good things," what does the "good fruit" of a genuine, submissive relationship with Jesus look like in everyday life?
3. In verses 22–23, the people Jesus turns away were busy with "ministry" (prophesying, casting out demons). How can we distinguish between serving Christ out of a saved heart and performing for Christ to mask an empty heart?
4. Paul commands us to "test ourselves" (2 Cor 13:5). What does a healthy, biblical self-examination look like? How can we examine our faith without falling into the trap of constant doubt or legalism?
